VP1 Words of the Day – Batch 1

1. **Aperture** The variable opening inside a lens that regulates the amount of light available to the camera. Also known as an iris.

2. Aspect Ratio The proportional width and height of the picture on the screen. The current standard for conventional receiver or monitor is four by three (4:3); 16:9 for HDTV.

3. **Digitize** To convert analog video, audio, or both to digital form. The process of converting a continuous analog video or audio signal to digital data (ones and zeros) for computer storage. The signal can then be copied repeatedly with no degradation.

4. **Pre-production** The planning phase of a film or video project, usually completed prior to shooting.

5. **Point of view (POV)** Movie Shot perspective whereby the camera assumes the subject's view, and thus viewers see what the subject sees as if through his/her/its eyes.
