Project Requirements:

You will create a short story with at least 2 characters, a setting, and a clear storyline.

Details on the subject matter for the story:

- At least 2 main characters – give as much detail about them as possible.
- The setting – including date, location, time, and any special details.
- A storyline with at least a beginning and body or body and ending.

Your finished story should be about 3-5 pages in length. Remember that you want to have as much detail in it as possible – with the possibility of adding to or deleting some of the detail as needed in the future.

Details on the written version of the short story:

- Short story will begin with a title page (not counted as a page #) that contains your name, period number, due date, draft version, and title.
- Short story text will be 3 to 5 pages typed (letter size, 1” margins on all sides, “space and a half” line spacing, 14 pt. Times Font.)
- Story must be written in past tense.
